St. Anne Parish has received certification to enter Phase I & IA of the Diocesan Reopening Plan. We are happy to announce that we may begin offering limited times for Private Prayer as well as Confessions by appointment.

**Private Prayer in the Chapel
Begins Tuesday, June 2, 2020**

**Tuesday and Thursday
9:00 AM-Noon**

**Wednesday
6:00-8:00 PM**

Please do not come if you are sick, have a fever or anyone in your household is sick.

Only 10 people will be allowed into the chapel and Joachim Center at one time.

You will be let into the Joachim Center by a Reopening Greeter.

Strict social distancing will be followed at all times.

Masks/Face Coverings must be worn at all times.

The Reopening Greeter will take your name and contact information for contact tracing purposes.

You will be asked to sanitize your hands and you will be led to the chapel.

Out of respect for all who wish to have prayer time, if someone is waiting we will ask that you limit your prayer time to 20 minutes.

There will be no socializing in the vestibule of the Joachim Center or the parking lot.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Please do not come if you are sick, have a fever or anyone in your household is sick.

Confessions will be by appointment only and will be celebrated in the Narthex of the church on folding chairs with social distancing.

You will be greeted at the main entrance of the Church. One person will be allowed into the Narthex at a time.

You will be asked to sanitize your hands.

Masks/face coverings are to be worn at all times.
