Please carefully read the instructions as to how to download and fill out the registration form. There is a special discounted rate for RE students who are signed up on or before June 28th. All registrations need to be completed by August 21st for the upcoming RE year. There is also additional information about how to sign up in today's bulletin. The RE program cannot function without the help of many volunteers. The volunteers in the parish RE program function as teachers, as aides, as office help, and as hall monitors (think of them as door wardens which is a much cooler sounding title).
