In this bulletin article I want to highlight several ongoing or upcoming events in the parish.

First, Vacation Bible School will start on July 24th and run through July 27th. You can find more information about VBS and sign up your child on the parish website. We are also looking for volunteers to help run VBS. If you are interested in volunteering, please contact the Religious Education Office.

Second, the feast day of our patron saint is coming up on Wednesday, July 26th. To celebrate we will have a special Mass on Wednesday, July 26th at 7pm. After Mass we will have a reception/picnic outside in the back parking lot and adjacent grassy areas under the trees. Don't worry about the lighting. Sunset is at 8.15pm that day and there will still be indirect sunlight for another 30 minutes after sunset. Not to mention the artificial lighting we have in the parking lot. The parish will be supplying snacks, drinks, and frozen custard for refreshments. I encourage you to bring lawn chairs.

Third, starting on the last weekend of July we will start having families once again bring the gifts forward to the altar during the weekend Masses.
