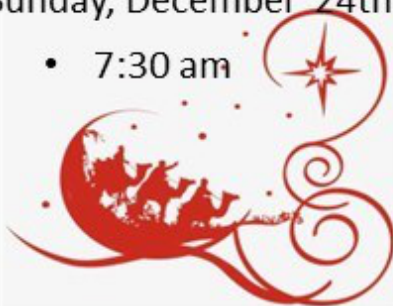

A NOTE FROM FATHER EICKHOFF

Now that we are in the Season of Advent, I want to go over the Christmas schedule. The big challenge this year is how Christmas Day falls on a Monday and how the Masses that day interact with the Fourth Sunday of Advent Masses on Saturday and Sunday. In order to provide time for the Arts and Environment Committee to decorate the Church for the Christmas Masses; to provide some time for rest for myself, the other priests who are helping with Masses here at St. Anne, and our other ministers and volunteers; and the realization that the likelihood of regular Mass goers of attending the 11AM Sunday Mass and then returning for the 4PM Christmas Eve Mass approaches zero; I have decided to trim down the number of Masses for the Fourth Sunday of Advent on Sunday morning. The schedule for Masses on December 23-25 follows:

Fourth Sunday of Advent Masses

Saturday, December 23rd – 5PM
Sunday, December 24th – 7.30AM

Christmas Eve Masses

Sunday, December 24th – 4PM
Sunday, December 24th – 6PM
Sunday, December 24th – 10PM

Christmas Day Masses

Monday, December 25th – 8AM
Monday, December 25th – 10AM

There are two obligations in effect during this time period. The first is to attend Mass on Sunday (or Saturday Vigil Mass); and the second is to attend Christmas Mass. The Christmas Eve Masses fulfill both obligations at once.

The schedule for the Sacrament of Reconciliation at St. Anne Parish is as follows through the end of December:

Saturday, December 16th at 3.30PM
Wednesday, December 20th at 7PM
Saturday, December 30th at 3.30PM

The last scheduled confessions before Christmas will be on Wednesday, December 20th.

The normally scheduled Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions on Wednesday, December 27th is canceled.

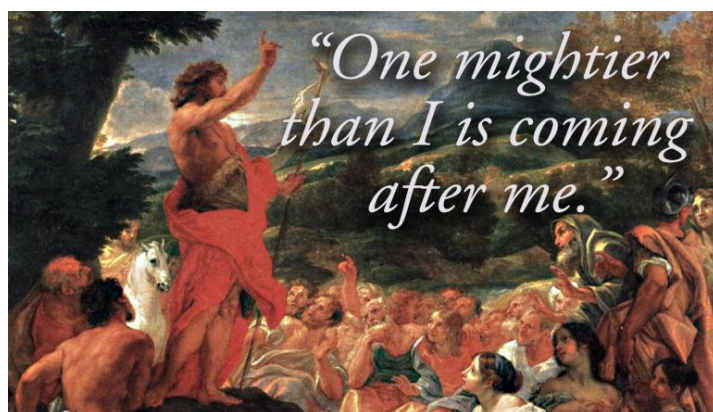

The Diocese of Joliet will return to Navajo Nation for a two-week mission focused on construction and outreach from June 1 to 14, 2024.

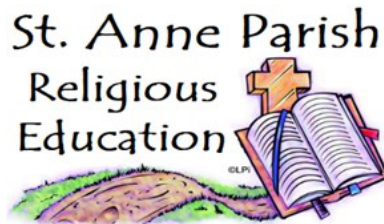
The Diocese of Joliet has been putting faith into action—through intentional service and solidarity with the poor—in Chinle, Arizona, for 20 years.

K-5 Family Scripture Connection

Both the First Reading and the Gospel for this 2nd Sunday of Advent tell us to "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." How do we prepare the way for Jesus? These same readings give us the answer. We repent! To repent means to be truly sorry for your sins, not because you got caught but because you know in your heart you made a bad choice, and you want to say you are sorry. But just being sorry isn't enough. If we are truly repentant, we want to do our best to make better choices the next time and not to sin again. This is hard to do but with the grace we receive in Baptism and Reconciliation, God gives us the tools we need. What do you have to repent for this Advent season? How will you use God's grace to turn away from sin and make better choices?

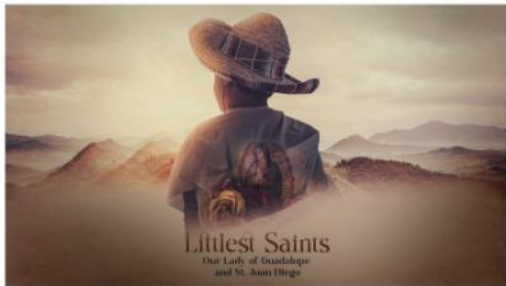

KENDALL COUNTY COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY

The Kendall County Community Food Pantry continues to serve families from the County in need of food assistance.

Interesting Statistics:

- ◆ 2,201 neighbors served with 939 being new in 2022
- ◆ 6,540 includes all family members of the neighbors fed in 2022
- ◆ 280 families (on average) were served per week in 2022 with a recent week serving 315
- ◆ 14,560 shopping carts were loaded up
- ◆ 72,800 meals provided per shopping cart. This assumes 5 meals can be made with each cart (which is a low number)
- ◆ \$175 assumption of what each cart is worth (again a low number), then...
- ◆ \$2,548,000 was saved by all households through food distribution at KCCFP

Cash donations go a long way. For every dollar donated, the pantry can purchase \$8.00 in food from the Northern Illinois Food Bank.

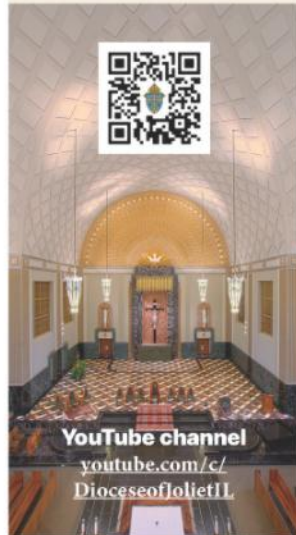

A wedding date may not be secured until meeting with the parish Deacon or Priest. At that time, the couple will be secured a date and begin the process of preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage.
