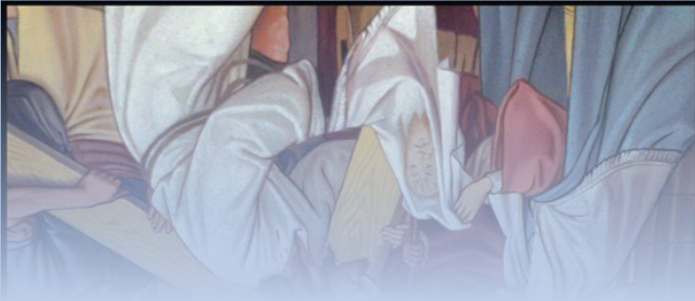
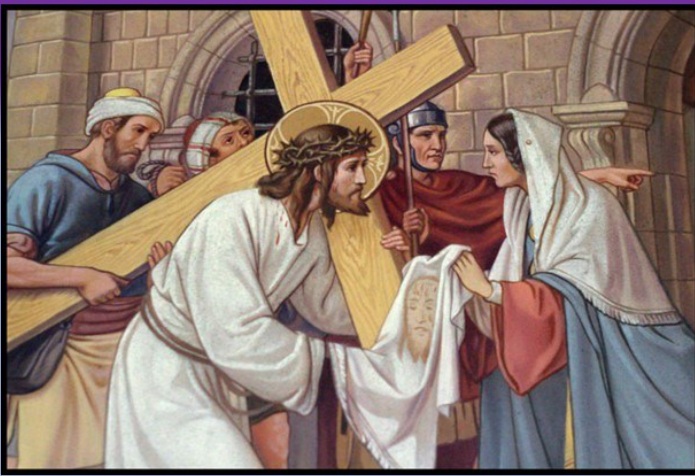

## A NOTE FROM FATHER EICKHOFF

The Gospel today states the watch phrase for the entirety of the Season of Lent:

"The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel."

This phrase has two parts that we need to keep in mind. The first part reminds us that God is always near to us. Not only in the sense of God being everywhere throughout creation, but also that the time when God will be revealed in all His might and splendor is coming near. True, we do not know exactly when that time will be. God works on His own schedule, not our schedule. However, it will come and every day, every hour, brings that time closer to fulfillment. And, when that time comes, we - God's creation - want to be ready to be part of His kingdom.

That leads us to the second part of the watch phrase for Lent. How do we become ready to become part of the Kingdom of God? Christ gives us the answer. First, we must cast aside our sinful ways that are foreign to God's goodness and teachings. All of the sinful attitudes and actions that are within us or come forth from within us must be swept out. This is the repentance portion of the watch phrase. Next, having swept out the vices and sins from within us we must replace them with the teachings of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who has come to free us from the power of sin and death.

This second part is difficult. It is painful and hard to make an honest account of our actions and habits and see where we have harmed ourselves, our neighbors, and our relationship with God. A serious review of our actions will reveal many mistakes we have made; whether they be intentional or made through callousness. Yet, it must be done if we are to truly repent for our actions and ask the Lord for forgiveness. Having sought the Lord's forgiveness and resolved to change from our former ways we next need to replace those former ways with God's ways. From the Word of God, Jesus Christ, we learn what God's ways are and so we seek not only to follow them, but also to make them a part of who we are. This is what we should be striving to do during the Season of Lent.

During the Season of Lent there are numerous opportunities to go to the Sacrament of Confession which is necessary to the repentance portion of the Lenten watch phrase. Confessions are heard every Wednesday evening 7pm-8pm and every Saturday afternoon from 3.30pm-4.30pm. In addition, there will be parish confessions on Sunday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 4pm when there will be several priests present.

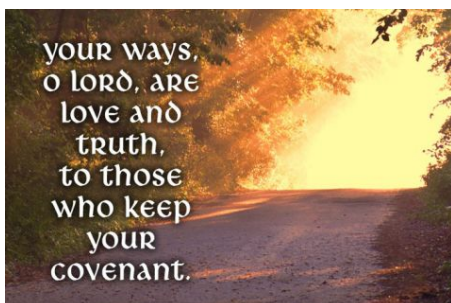

## The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

Who are the Elect and what are the Scrutinies?

On the First Sunday of Lent, catechumens (those who are unbaptized) celebrate the Rite of Election and enter the period of Purification and Enlightenment, which leads to the celebration of the Easter sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). Election comes from a word which means "choose". The Rite of Election reflects the fact that God has chosen and called us.

When we scrutinize something, we look at it carefully and examine it closely. With the O.C.I.A., the Rites called the Scrutinies "are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the Elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good" (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, #141). The Elect look within themselves to find anything that keeps from Christ. Then they look to Christ to heal those weaknesses and strengthen them when they face temptation.

Three Scrutinies for the Elect occur on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent.

The Scrutinies take place after the Homily.

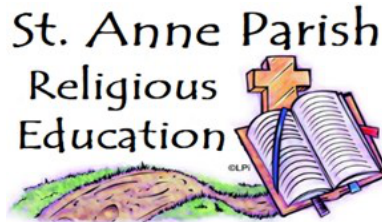

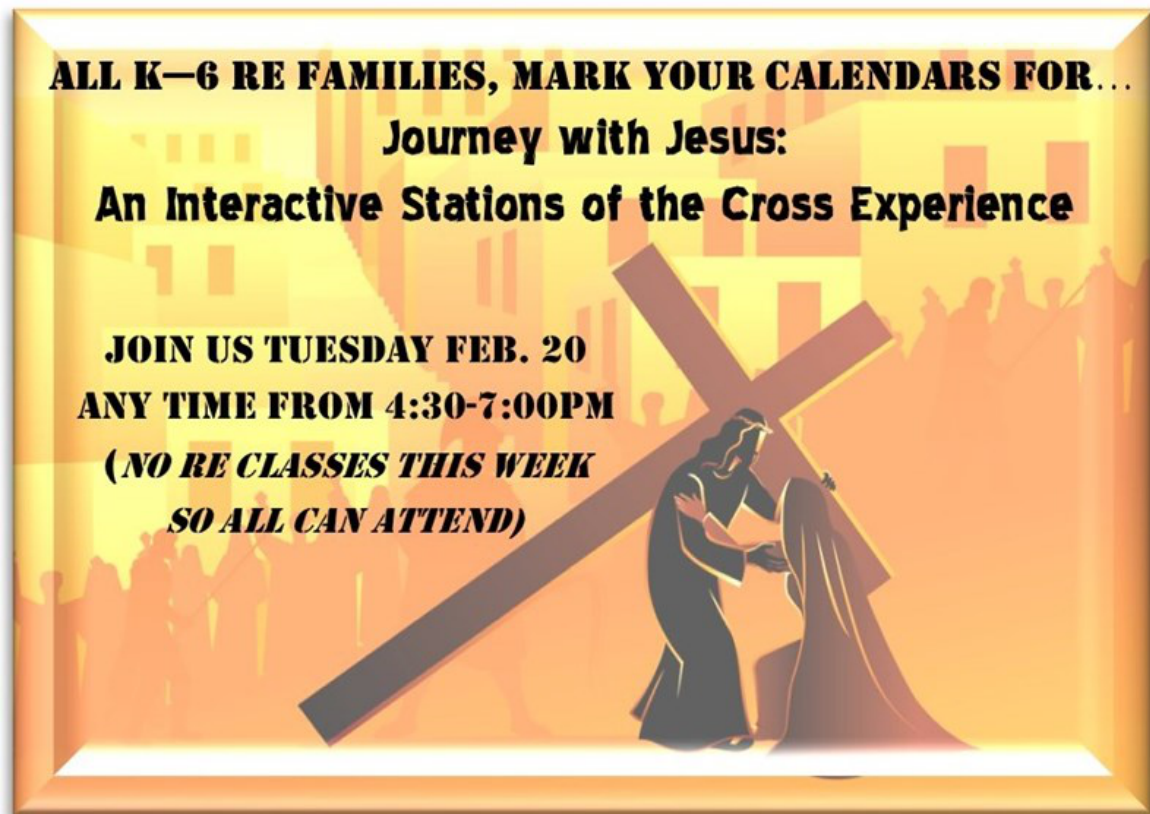

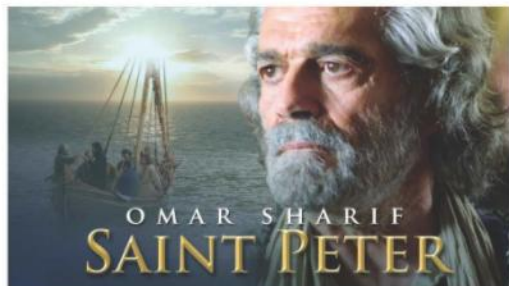

### KENDALL COUNTY COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY

The Kendall County Community Food Pantry continues to serve families from the County in need of food assistance.

#### Interesting Statistics:

- ◆ 2,201 neighbors served with 939 being new in 2022
- ◆ 6,540 includes all family members of the neighbors fed in 2022
- ◆ 280 families (on average) were served per week in 2022 with a recent week serving 315
- ◆ 14,560 shopping carts were loaded up
- ◆ 72,800 meals provided per shopping cart. This assumes 5 meals can be made with each cart (which is a low number)
- ◆ \$175 assumption of what each cart is worth (again a low number), then...
- ◆ \$2,548,000 was saved by all households through food distribution at KCCFP

Cash donations go a long way. For every dollar donated, the pantry can purchase \$8.00 in food from the Northern Illinois Food Bank.

As a welcoming Catholic community, we strive to be disciples of Jesus glorifying His true presence in the Eucharist. Just as St. Anne was called by God, we are called as faithful witnesses to celebrate the Sacraments, honor traditions and nurture the family by studying, praying and proclaiming the Good News through service and evangelization.

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are generally held the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month (some months this may vary) at 12:30 PM. Expectant parents are to call the Parish Office, six months before the birth of their child for preparation information. **Please do not choose Godparents until you receive the established Church guidelines for Godparents.**

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage should call the parish office at least six months before the date of marriage. A wedding date may not be secured until meeting with the parish Deacon or Priest. At that time, the couple will be secured a date and begin the process of preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

If there is anyone at home who cannot get to Mass and the Sacraments because of illness or age, please call the parish office at anytime to request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
