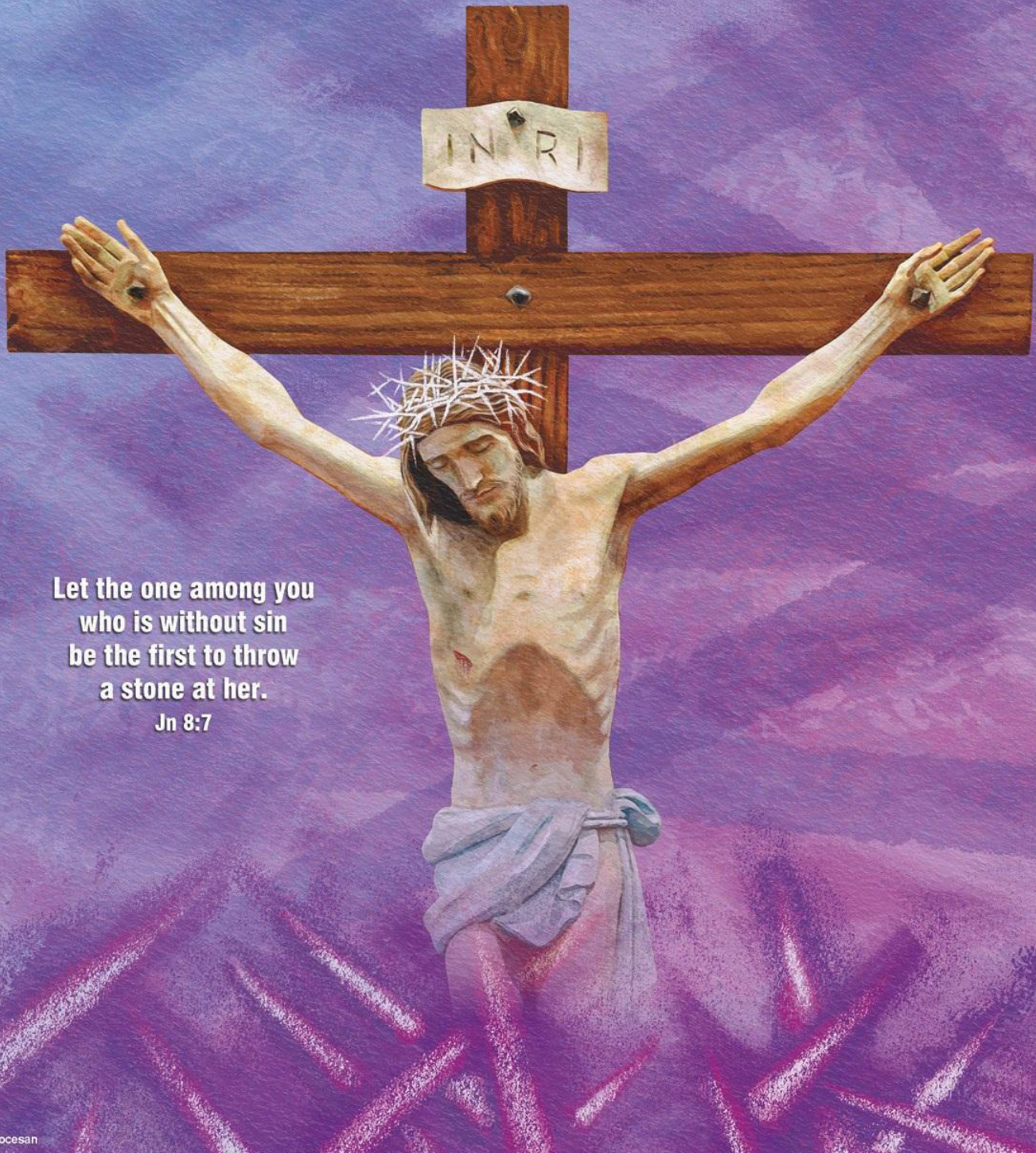

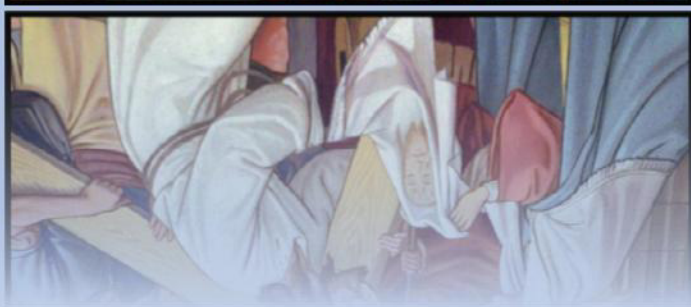

## A NOTE FROM FATHER EICKHOFF

Christmas in our society gets all the attention. It is a holiday that creates the setting for countless movies and songs. There are cultural traditions such as Santa Claus and gifts. Easter on the other hand does not get all that much attention in our society. However, for Christians Easter is the more important day. Without the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ there would be no reason to celebrate Christmas. We should take care to during Holy Week and Easter to take the time to praise God for all His gifts to us that come from the suffering, death, and resurrection of His Son. Prayer booklets will be provided. Also note that on Holy Thursday there will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from the end of the Mass of the Lord's Supper until midnight. Everyone is welcome to pray in the church during this time. There is also an old Catholic tradition of visiting nearby parishes on Holy Thursday night that you might want to try. A listing of nearby Catholic parishes will be provided next week.

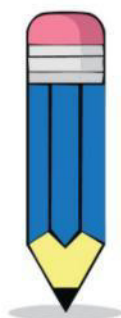
## Family Car Talk

As a welcoming Catholic community, we strive to be disciples of Jesus glorifying His true presence in the Eucharist. Just as St. Anne was called by God, we are called as faithful witnesses to celebrate the Sacraments, honor traditions and nurture the family by studying, praying and proclaiming the Good News through service and evangelization.

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are generally held the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month (some months this may vary) at 12:30 PM. Expectant parents are to call the Parish Office, six months before the birth of their child for preparation information. **Please do not choose Godparents until you receive the established Church guidelines for Godparents.**

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage should call the parish office at least six months before the date of marriage. A wedding date may not be secured until meeting with the parish Deacon or Priest. At that time, the couple will be secured a date and begin the process of preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

If there is anyone at home who cannot get to Mass and the Sacraments because of illness or age, please call the parish office at anytime to request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
